The Life Economy values all organic co-creation, which, through direct current, carries the intentional manifestation of our collective reality.

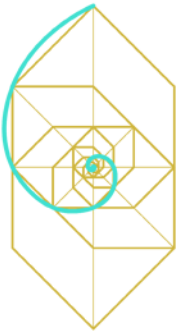

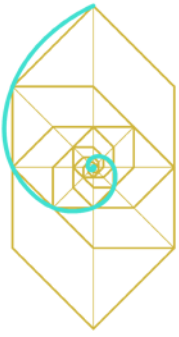
The Life Economy Fosters New Rules of Operation for Keystone Earth

Mission

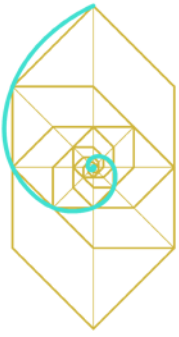

Introduction

There are many forms of community and professional service cooperatives, each one with the purpose of providing services or facilities to the members that ease the burdens of daily life while providing positive outlets for family and children to gather and socialize.



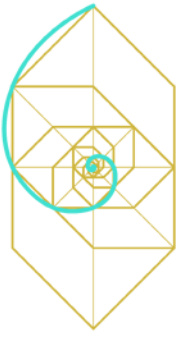
Community Cooperatives

Examples of what a Community Cooperative may coordinate to serve its people

- Cooperatively run youth programs.
- Cooperatively networked counseling services.
- Cooperatively supported and coordinated single-parent support services.
- Cooperatively operated event and conference facilities, libraries, rinks/arenas, and indoor and outdoor sports complexes.
- Cooperatively operated theater, film, media, and arts programs, museums, and other venues that nurture cultural restoration.
- Locally speaking, starting a local Restoration Radio program can help support the reporting of progress and calls to action, acting as a “squawk box” of all that is happening in your community.

Professional Service Cooperatives

Professional Service Cooperatives play a part in supporting families, businesses, and individuals with specialized services, such as an architect who cooperatively leases, rents, and shares office space with other draftspeople and architects. In this instance, these professionals may offer services for minor profit, or not at all, depending on the mandate of the cooperative and the exchange of skills, trades, products, or services they wish to negotiate in kind, by a transparent exchange contract, with other neighborhood cooperatives.

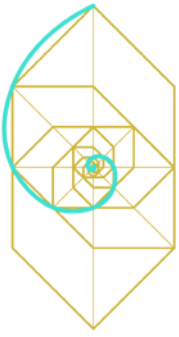


Let's start with some basics - What is a Community Cooperative?

- A community cooperative is a member-organized and managed, collaborative entity created for the benefit of providing services, facilities, or programs to neighborhoods or communities.
- Community Cooperatives are run by people who care about the lifestyle needs of their neighborhoods and communities.
 - One example of a community cooperative may be a thrift store owned and operated by the community, or,
 - An artisanal cooperative facility for artists.
- Community Cooperatives will locally ensure neighborhoods have all the things they need for an enriching quality of life.
- Members of Community Cooperatives operate for the greater good of the community and seek ways to support and build community-based projects that build a stronger vibe for everyone.
- Community Cooperatives are key to the success of the clusters as the whole community has much to gain by working together to build structures that bring optimal living standards to everyone.

What is a Professional Service Cooperative?

- A Professional Service Cooperative is also a member-organized and managed collaborative entity, created for cost sharing of overheads and other costs of conducting knowledge-based businesses with other professionals, such as accountants, lawyers, consultants, computer systems, software developers, etc.
- A Professional Service Cooperative may be a profit or non-profit cooperative depending on the founders' intentions.

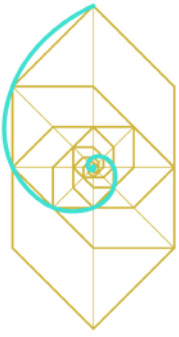
Abundance **Must Start Locally!**

Co-creation, maintenance, development, or restoration of anything community shared is locally and mindfully managed and monitored for its direct impact on the community's general level of happiness.

The advancement of community-based projects is best governed by a collaborative process of full transparency and consensus, which is guided by the community clusters and those with whom they cooperate. Keeping an open dialogue of inclusivity with everyone in the community is essential in nurturing any project to success.

Everyone has a place in the restoration since skills can be directly traded for skills, or things for things.

It is all a matter of a change of perspective.



Community and Professional Service Cooperatives Deliverables in The Golden Age

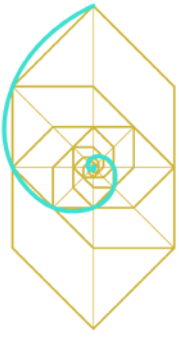
Provision of shared community opportunities, services, and facilities that support families and all people in achieving balance in their lives while we collectively restore the planet.

- Set up open meetings for dialogue on community transformation or restoration projects ripe for cooperative action.
- Review the local supply chain for building or equipment items that can be produced locally to support community transition initiatives.

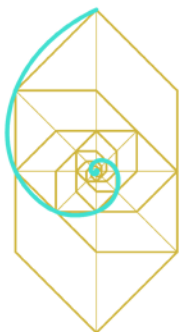

Coordinator Deliverables in The Golden Age

- 1. Enhance work-life-family balance and shared prosperity by building local Community Currency Cluster Cooperatives in the Professional Services sector**
 - Coordinate community project development with associated cooperatives and project creators using the **Community Cooperative Currency Cluster (CCCC)** model.
 - Coordinate shared services, facilities, and community opportunities that encourage balanced living and support families and individuals as we work together towards a successful restoration transition.
 - Support the development of a robust Local Cooperative network to bolster the currency cluster model.
- 2. Work with local needs service providers to develop assessment deliverables (solutions) that meet Golden Age Standards**
 - Analyze the local Community and Professional supply chain to identify goods and services that can be coordinated and provided locally to support community transition initiatives.
- 3. Build a Golden Age Standard Operating Procedure (SOP) Document for this sector**

 - Share the SOP document with all partnering cooperatives.
 - Review, revise, and maintain the SOP at Golden Age Standards Levels.

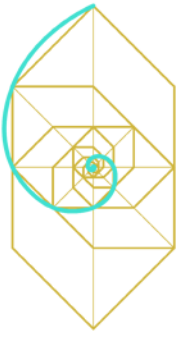

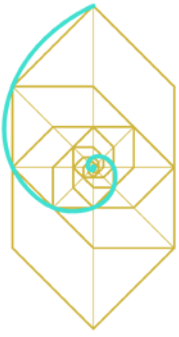

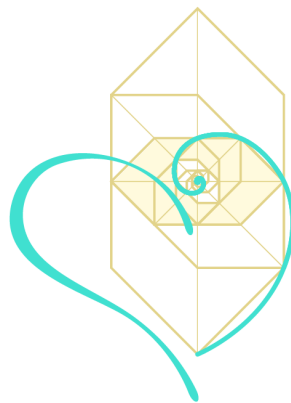
